

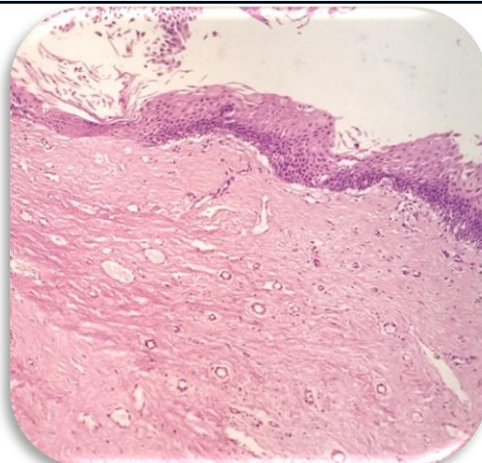

#### Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus with fibrocollagenous tissue and mononuclear inflammatory cells.
2. No malignant and no granuloma seen.
