

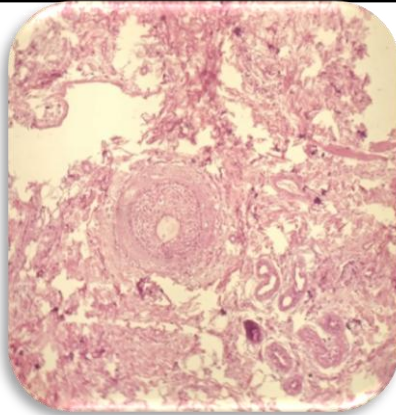

Received 3x0.5 cm greyish white tissue piece with skin.

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous epithelial lining with fibrocollagenous tissue, glands, mature adipose cells, multinucleated giant cells and inflammatory cells.
2. No malignant and no granuloma seen.
