

DIAGNOSIS

METASTATIC PAPILLARY CARCINOMA OF THYROID



SPECIMEN **Cervical Lymph Nodes** GROSSING Received 2x3.1 cm lymph node.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows lymph node with presence of numerous true papillae with complex, branching which are randomly oriented with a central fibrovascular core, filled with colloid and lined by single to stratified lining of cuboidal cells intermixed with lymphoid follicles.
- 2. Cuboidal cells shows nuclear features consisting of ground glass (optically clear) nuclei, nuclear grooves and scanty mitosis.
- 3. Presence of Psammoma bodies in the subcapsular area of the lymph node.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request for any of the above will be entertained after the due date.
