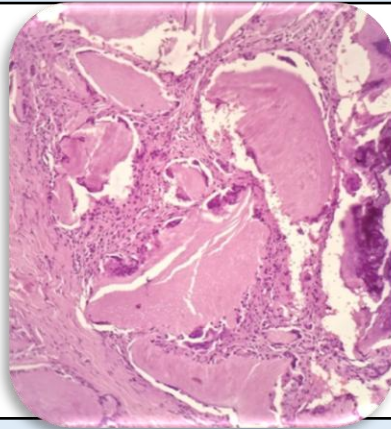
## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

#### SPECIMEN

Sebaceous Cyst (Right Breast)

#### GROSS

Received multiple greyish white tissue piece.

#### Microscopy

1. Section examined shows mature adipose cells and calcified tissue surrounded by mononuclear inflammatory cells, multinucleated giant cells.
2. No malignant cells and no granuloma seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
