

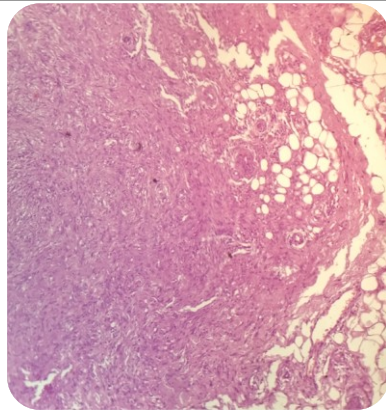

#### Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous lining epithelial, deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue, mature adipose cells, nerve bundles and sebaceous glands.
