

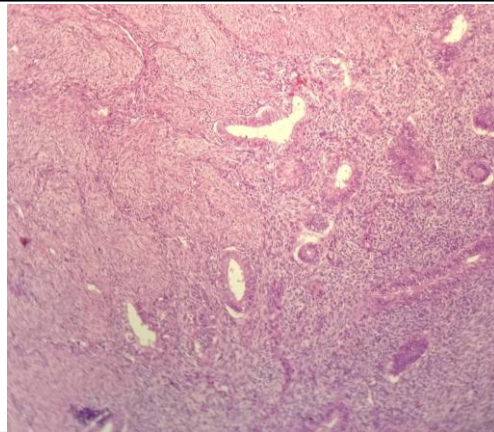

#### Microscopy


Section examined shows

1. Endometrium with proliferative phase.
2. Myometrium with muscle bundles.
3. cervix with mono nuclear inflammatory cells.
4. Ovary and tube unremarkable.
5. Other ovary and tube unremarkable.
