

#### **GROSSING**

Received 4x2 cm cystic tissue piece. Cut section shows membrane.

## Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows cystic cavity containing the larval form with duct like invaginations, lined by two layered, eosinophilic membrane, scolex with birefringent hooklets and pairs of suckers.
- 2. Presence of variable granulomatous reaction, inflammatory cells chiefly composed of lymphocytes, plasma cells and histiocytes.

**Note**: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request for any of the above will be entertained after the due date.
