

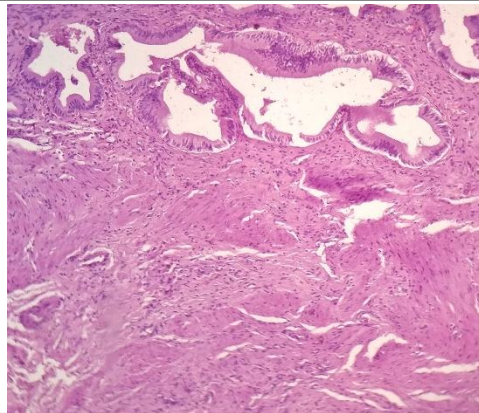

GALL BLADDER.

DIAGNOSIS

CHOLECYSTITIS WITH CHOLELITHIASIS WITH POLYP



SPECIMEN

Gall Bladder.

GROSS

Received 6.5x3.1cm long gall bladder already cut open 1x1 cm polyp .

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
2. Polyp shows mucosal lining epithelium with columnar cells and round nucleus .

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above will be entertained after the due date.
