

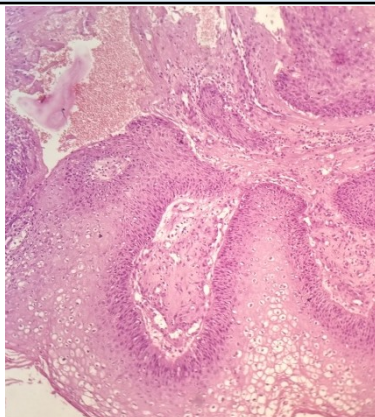

DIAGNOSIS

CHRONIC NON-SPECIFIC INFLAMMATION



SPECIMEN

Glans Penis

GROSS

Received 1x1cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous epithelial lining with mild atypia involving the lower third cell layer thickness and mild hyperkeratosis with round to oval nucleus.
2. Deeper tissue shows fibro collagenous tissue, blood vessels and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes, polymorphs and plasma cells)
3. No malignant cells and no granuloma seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above will be entertained after the due date.
