

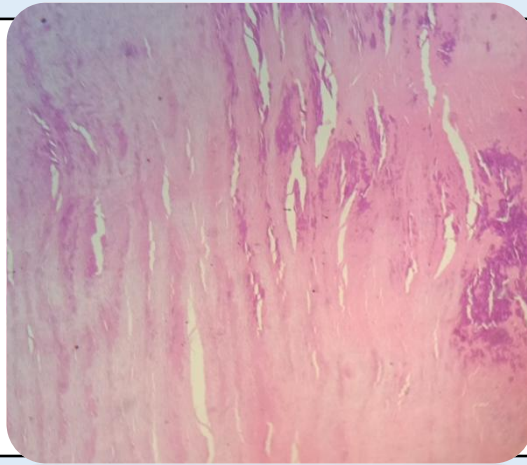

Received 8x3cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous epithelial lining epithelial with round nucleus and hyperkeratosis and Para keratosis. Deeper tissue shows fibro collagenous tissue and few inflammatory cells. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
