

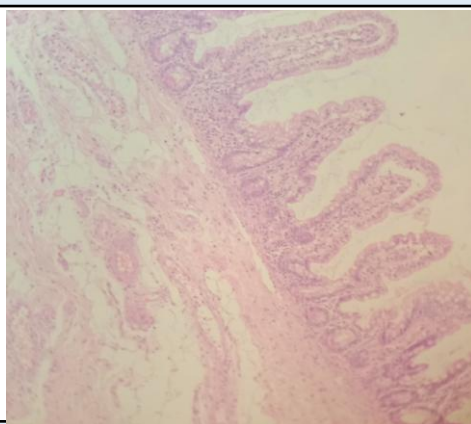

## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### Resected intestinal loop

#### DIAGNOSIS

**Suggestive of chronic granulomatous reactions  
(Tuberclopathology strongly suspicious )**



#### SPECIMEN

Resected intestinal loop

#### GROSS

Received 30x7cm long bowl with tiny perforation in the mid portion 0.1x0.1cm cut section shows 2x2cm ulcer .

#### Microscopy

Section examined shows

Proximal end shows villi with sub mucosal glands and inflammatory cells.

No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

Distal end shows villi with sub mucosal glands with lymphoid follicles.

Perforations / ulcer section examined shows lymphoid follicle with ( lymphocyte, centrocytes).

Section also shows epithelioid cells granuloma with multinucleated giant cells.

Section also shows polymorphs and no malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above will be entertained after the due date.
