

GROSS

Received 3x2 cm greyish white tissue piece with calcified areas.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous epithelial lining with mild anisonucleosis, hyperkeratosis and
 parakeratosis with round to oval nucleus.
 Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue along with calcified areas, multinucleated giant
 cells and mononuclear cell infiltrate.
- 2. No malignant cells and no granuloma seen.
