

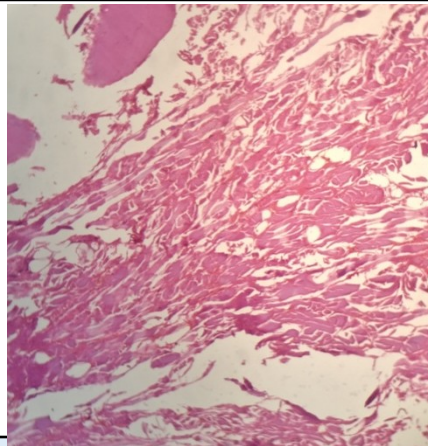

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium, keratin, muscle bundles, mature adipose cells.
2. No malignant cells and no granuloma seen.
