

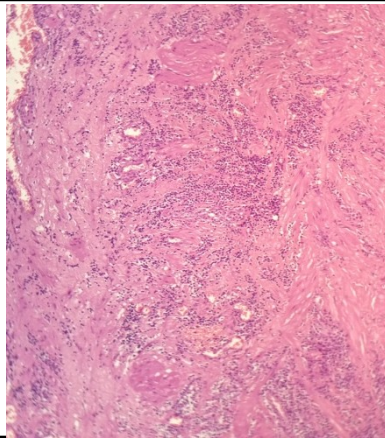

#### GROSS

Received two tissue piece 3x2cm, 2.5x2 cm greyish white tissue piece.

#### Microscopy

1. Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue with mononuclear inflammatory cells (lymphocytes, centrocytes, plasma cells and histiocytes) with muscle bundles.
2. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
