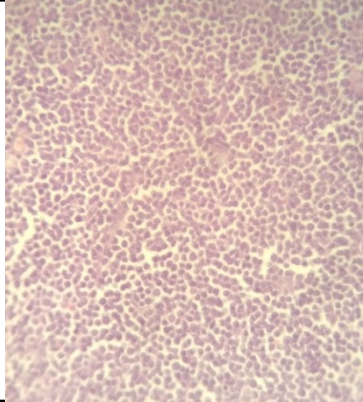
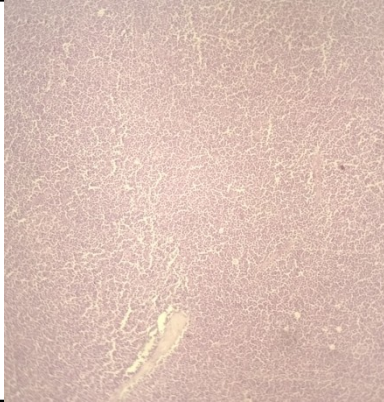
## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

Multiple cervical lymph nodes (Right Jugular Chain)

### DIAGNOSIS

### NON-HODGKINS LYMPHOMA

**Advised:** Immunohistochemistry studies with CD5, CD23 and CD 43 markers for further evaluation and categorization of Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma.



#### SPECIMEN

Multiple cervical lymph nodes (Right Jugular Chain)

#### Microscopy

- Section examined shows effacement of lymphoid architecture with monotonous population of small round monomorphic lymphocytes with clumped chromatin, inconspicuous nucleoli and scanty mitotic activities.
- Presence of few occasional centrocytes.
- No granuloma seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
