

Received autolyzed 4.8x3.9 cm cystic greyish white tissue piece. Cut section shows cheesy material

- 1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with small round nucleus.
- 2. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagneous tissue, blood vessels with few inflammatory cells.
- 3. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
