

SPECIMEN

- (I) Mesentric Lymph Node
- (II) Omentum

GROSS

- (I) Received 1x1cm greyish white tissue piece.
- (II) Received 2.5x2 cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- (I) Section examined shows lymphoid follicles with epitheloid cells, granuloma formation and caseous necrosis. Section also shows multinucleated giant cells.
- (II) Section examined shows mature adipose cells with fibrocollagensou tissue, large number of blood vessels (lymphocyte, polymorphs), epitheloid cells and multinucleated giant cells.

Note: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
