

Received multiple greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with small round nucleus. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels and large number of inflammatory cells (Lymphocytes, polymorphs and histiocytes).
- 2. No malignant cells and no granuloma seen.
