

#### **GROSS**

Received tiny greyish white tissue piece.

### Microscopy

- Section examined shows multiple bits of tissues with transitional lining epithelium forming
  papillae (finger like projections) in few areas, also, few areas shows mild anisonucleosis involving
  the lower thickness of epithelium.
- 2. Stroma shows inflammatory cells, fibrocollagenous tissue and blood vessels.
