

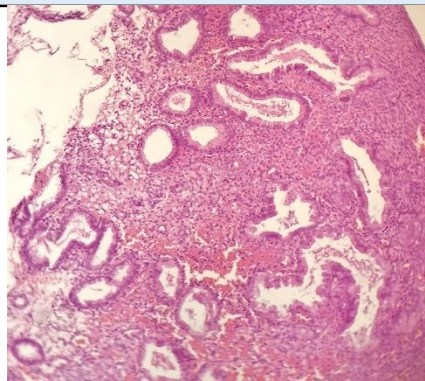

#### GROSS

Received multiple greyish white tissue piece.

#### Microscopy

1. Section examined shows endocervical glands with columnar lining epithelium and round to oval nucleus with stromal and inflammatory cells.
2. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
