

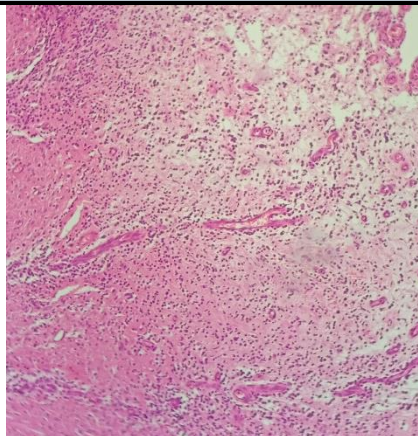

GROSS

Received 2.1 x1.6 cm cm long tubular piece with skin attached.

Microscopy

Section examined shows ulcerative lining epithelium. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollageneous cells, blood vessels with large number of mononuclear inflammatory cells, lymphocytes, plasma cells. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
