

Parasitic (cysticercosis) infestation with inflammation.

GROSS

Received two 1x1cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows fibro collagenous tissue, inflammatory cells (lymphocyte, macrophages, polymorphs). Section also shows? degenerated membranous tissue, cystic cavity with duct like invagination with eosinophilic membrane.

No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
