

BENIGN PROSTATIC HYPERPLASIA



SPECIMEN TURP chips **GROSS**

Received multiple greyish white tissue piece 4x3cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

Section examined shows bilayered prostatic glands with columnar lining epithelium and with small round to oval nucleus surrounded by large number of fibrocollagenous tissue and mononuclear inflammatory cell.
