

Received 2x1cm greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows submucosal glands having columnar lining epithelium surrounding by fibro collagenous tissue and large number of inflammatory cells (Plasma cells, lymphocytes, polymorphs and eosinophils). No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
