

GROSS

Received 5.9x2.8cm long gall bladder cut section shows without stones.

Microscopy

 Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
