

Endometrial polyp with early secretary phase

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows small and broken endometrial glands with cuboidal lining epithelium. Stroma shows mononuclear inflammatory cells and fibrin.

Section also shows squamous metaplasia.

No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
