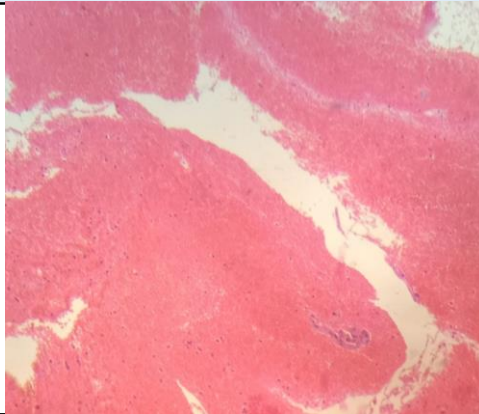
SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

DIAGNOSIS

Suggestive of dysplastic epithelium.

SPECIMEN

Cervical biopsy

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows scanty cellularity of cervical epithelium. Cells shows round nucleus with few cells shows large atypical nucleus and large number of RBCs.
