

Consistent with clinical diagnosis (TORSION OF TESTES)

Torsion of testes

Received 5x4 cm testes with epididymis. Cut section shows blood clot.

Microscopy

Testes: Section examined shows membrane with large number of blood vessels and RBCs, seminiferous tubules shows necrotic changes with immature spermatogenic cells surrounded by supporting cells. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

Epididymus: Section examined shows large number of blood vessels filled with RBCs.

Note: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
