

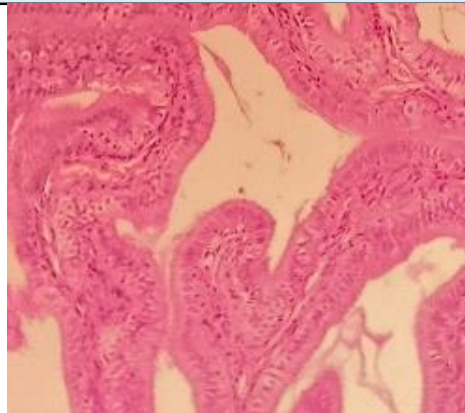

## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### Gall bladder

#### DIAGNOSIS

#### CHOLECYSTITIS



#### SPECIMEN

Gall bladder

#### GROSS

Received 5.9x2.8cm long gall bladder already cut open without stones.

#### Microscopy

Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and Rokitansky-Aschoff sinuses (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
