

DIAGNOSIS

Irritational Fibroma (Inflammed)



SPECIMEN

Ulcer on the right ventral surface of the toungue.

GROSS

Ulcer on the right ventral surface of the toung.

Microscopy

Section examined shows stratified squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus and long and slender few fused to each other) rete pegs overlying the connective tissue stroma. Stroma reveals bundles of collagen fibers interspersed with plump fibroblasts and fibrocytes. Presence of dense and diffuse inflammatory infiltrate present in the deeper part of stroma chiefly composed of neutrophils, lymphocytes, eosinophils and plasma cells. Numerous endotheial lined blood capillaried fillsed with RBCs are also evident.
