

Received 4x3cm grayish white tissue piece cut section shows calcified tissue.

### Microscopy

 Section examined shows autolyzed lining epithelium ,fibro collagenous tissue mature adipose cells few inflammatory cells9Lymphocytes, plasma cells.

No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
