

Gall bladder

GROSS

Received 7.1x2.8cm long gall bladder wall thickened 0.7cm. Cut section shows stones.

Microscopy

Section examined shows autolytic changes with ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped

tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).

Note: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
