

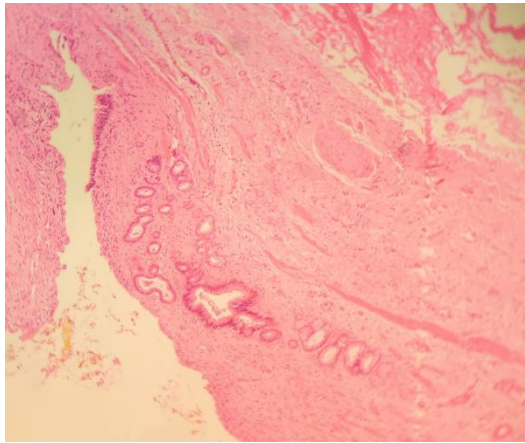

## SURGICAL PATHOLOGY REPORT

### TURP Chips + Prostatic Abscess

#### DIAGNOSIS

#### **BENIGN PROSTATIC HYPERPLASIA WITH PROSTATITIS**



#### **SPECIMEN**

TURP Chips + Prostatic Abscess

#### **GROSS**

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece, 4x4 cm in aggregate. Weight 4.0 grams.

#### **Microscopy**

1. Section examined shows bilayered prostatic glands with columnar lining epithelium and with small round to oval nucleus surrounded by large number of fibrocollagenous tissue and mononuclear inflammatory cell.
2. Section also shows large number of inflammatory cells (Lymphocytes and polymorphs).
3. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

**Note :** All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
