

Received 10x3.8cm long gall bladder already cut open with stones. Wall thickness 0.3 mm.

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa with mild anisonucleosis and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
