

DIAGNOSIS

Benign bone lesion strongly suspicious of Osteochondroma



SPECIMEN Left Proximal femur **GROSS** Received multiple grayish white tissue piece, 5x4 cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

Section examined shows bony trabeculae with marrow fats and marrow cells cartilage hyaline. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
