

Splenic rupture with Laceration.

Received 11x8x4cm spleen with 9x1 cm laceration. Weigh 130 grams.

Microscopy

Section examined shows capsule with lymphoid follicles (lymphocytes centrocytes), blood vessels and hemorrhage.

Helium is unremarkable.

Capsules is ulcerated capsules and hemorrhage seen.

No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
