

CHOLECYSTITIS AND CHOLELITHIASIS.



SPECIMENGall Bladder

GROSS

Received 7.7x2.4cm long gall bladder. Cut section shows stones. Wall thickness 0.7 mm.

Microscopy

Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes) and multinucleated giant cells.

Note: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
