

Received tiny greyish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with round nucleus. Section also shows stromal cells, blood vessels. Presence of epithelial cells with round to oval nucleus with mild anisonucleosis with myoepithelial cells.
