

Received autolyzed 6.2x2.6 cm long gall bladder already cut open with shows stones. Wall Thickness 0.5 mm

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows autolytic changes in the tissue with ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
