

Received 5.5x4.9 cm long gall bladder already cut open with stones largest thickened wall 10.0 mm $\,$.

Microscopy

Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes). No granuloma and no ,malignant cells seen.
