

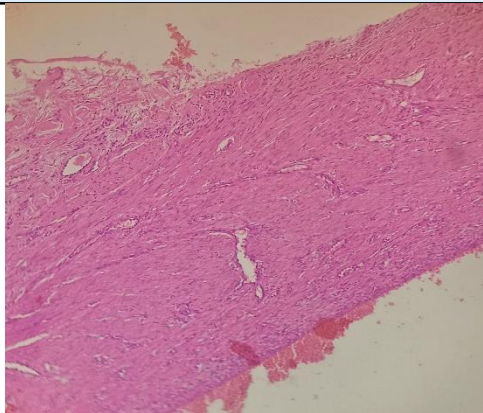

#### GROSS

Received 4x3 cm grayish white tissue piece. Cut section shows mucoid material.

#### Microscopy

Section examined shows lining epithelium with fibro collagenous tissue, RBCs, mucoid material. No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
