

Sebaceous Cyst with Foreign Body Type of Reaction.



SPECIMEN

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece, 3.2x4 cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus with keratosis and parakeratosis and keratin flakes. Deeper tissue shows fibro collagenous tissue, blood vessels, Multinucleated giant cells and inflammatory cells No granuloma and no malignant cells seen.
