

## **GROSS** Received tiny greyish white tissue piece.

#### Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows submucosal glands with columnar lining epithelium with small round to oval nucleus surrounded by fibrocollagneous tissue, blood vessels and few inflammatory cells.
- 2. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen in sample received.
