

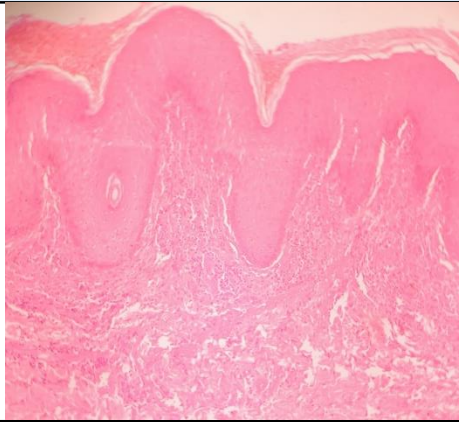

Incision and Drainage (Back of Neck)

DIAGNOSIS

INFECTED SEBACEOUS CYST.



SPECIMEN

Incision and Drainage (Back of Neck)

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece with attached skin measuring 1x1.9 cm in aggregate.


Microscopy

1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with hyperkeratosis and parakeratosis with keratin flakes.
2. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes and plasma cells).
3. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
