

SPECIMEN

GROSS

Received two grayish white tissue piece 1x1 cm, 0.5x0.5 cm.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus.
- 2. Deeper tissue shows large number of inflammatory cells (plasmacytoid cells, histiocytes, lymphocytes), fibrocollagneous tissue and blood vessels.
- 3. No malignant cells seen.

Note: All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request ,for any of the above ,will be entertained after the due date.
