

### DIAGNOSIS

## CHOLECYSTITIS AND CHOLELITHIASIS.



SPECIMEN Gall Bladder **GROSS** Received 5.2x2.1 cm long gall bladder. Cut section shows stones.

#### Microscopy

 Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibrocollagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
