

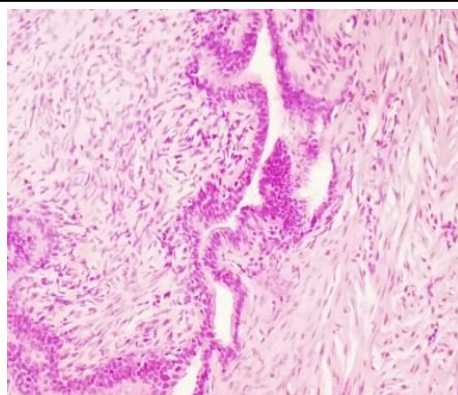

Section examined shows Trophoblastic cells and Decidual cells with blood clot.

No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
