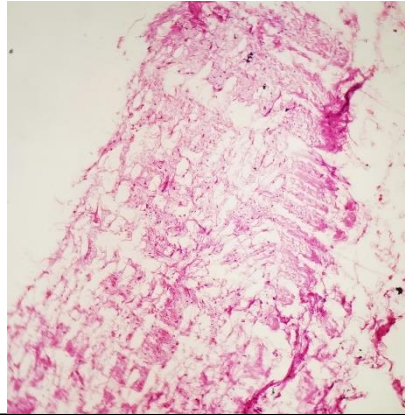

Microscopy

1. Section examined shows fibrocollagenous tissue, blood vessels, nerve bundle and few areas of mature adipose cells .
2. No granuloma seen.
3. No malignant cells seen.
