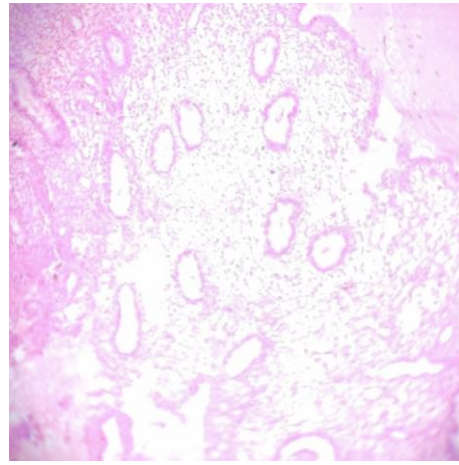
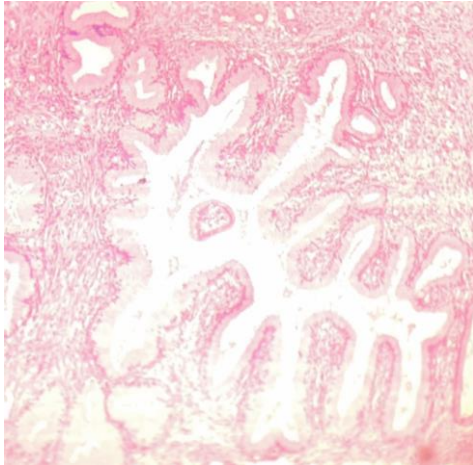

**GROSS**

A)Received 1x1.2 cm grayish white tissue piece.  
B) Received multiple grayish white tissue piece.

**Microscopy**

A) Section examined shows small endocervical glands with cuboidal lining with small round to oval nucleus. Stroma shows mononuclear inflammatory cells. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

B) Section examined shows small and tortuous endometrial glands with cuboidal lining with small round to oval nucleus. Stroma shows mononuclear inflammatory cells. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
