

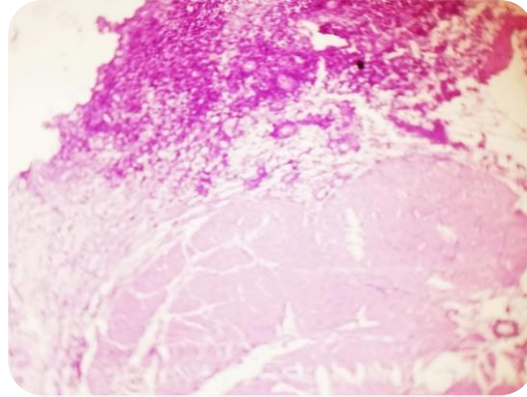

Section examined shows muscle bundle, fibrocollagenous tissue and mononuclear inflammatory cell. Occasional broken prostatic glands seen.
